What?

- Work towards a Nationally recognised qualification while completing high school: **MUST** complete a minimum of 375 paid hours in the first 50 weeks or 750 hours for a Cert. III in Retail. Must attend theory training with ARC: **MUST** have parent & school permission.
- Complete assessments related to your job. In most cases you can do paid work on weekends, school holidays, after school and/or one school day a week. Theoretical training with ARC will occur roughly once a month at school or the ARC campus. Electives can be tailored to suit your job role where possible. See Web site for elective options.

- Contributes up to 8 points towards your QCE when completed for QLD
- Offers a Nationally recognised qualification
- Shows future employers commitment
- Training cost subsidised by State Government if eligible
- Gain valuable experience & skills applicable in a range of industries finance, health, banking, retail, business

- Increases confidence & self esteem
- Can be used as a stepping stone into further study
